

Swimming Pool Internal Regulations – Agriturismo “Le Anfore”

Pursuant to Art. 10 of Regional Law no. 8/2006 and Regulation 23/R of 26 February 2010 of the Tuscany Region,

all guests are required to comply with the following rules in order to ensure safety, hygiene, and the proper functioning of the swimming pool.

a)	The maximum number of bathers allowed in the pool at the same time is set at 24. Only guests who have completed the check-in procedure are permitted to use the swimming pool.
b)	The pool has a minimum depth of 1.00 meters and a maximum depth of 1.40 meters, clearly indicated along the pool edge. The pool is not equipped with a handrail: please exercise extra caution when using the ladder.
c)	Diving is prohibited due to the shallow depth. Running around the pool perimeter is forbidden to prevent accidents and avoid disturbing other guests.
d)	It is strongly recommended not to swim until at least three hours after meals.
e)	Non-slip footwear is mandatory in areas where guests walk barefoot.
f)	A full shower and the use of the footbath are mandatory before entering the pool.
g)	In case of necessity, guests may use the toilets and changing rooms located inside the accommodation facility.
h)	Guests may use the pool every day from 09:00 to 21:00. Access to the pool area outside opening hours is prohibited. Climbing over the fence to enter the pool area is strictly forbidden.
i)	The pool is not supervised by a lifeguard. Children under 14 must be supervised by a parent or a responsible adult. Children under 16 are required to wear a swimming cap.
j)	Ball games and any behaviour that may disturb other guests are prohibited. Guests are invited to maintain respectful and decorous conduct.
k)	Entry into the water is prohibited in the presence of: open wounds, skin infections, fever, transmissible diseases, or gastrointestinal disorders. Entering the water during thunderstorms is forbidden, and remaining under open

	umbrellas in strong winds is discouraged.
l)	In case of emergency, promptly contact the facility staff at 0578 267252 or call the Emergency Number 112
m)	The first aid room is located inside the accommodation facility and is accessible if needed. A first aid kit, compliant with current regulations, is also available for minor interventions.
n)	It is forbidden to bring food and/or drinks in glass containers or other hazardous materials into the pool area. Please use the designated area for consuming food and beverages.
o)	The use of water-resistant sunscreen is recommended.
